Number of institutions = 189; percentage European 77\%
Sample Screen: Sorted by Overall learning experience
For students includes two approaches, One is by seven selected subject areas and the second, by "Compare" either institutions as a whole or by eight broad fields of study. Both emphasize metrics in teaching \& learning

Both have four steps; including subject coverage (or none as an option in Compare); type of university, with 6 options; location and then comparison. The choices for students by subject are very limited. Student survey data is dependent on subject. The number of institutions participating in this module is very limited. In Example 12.1, the subject area physics includes only 189 universities offering undergraduate programs in Physics

What is important to remember about For Students? That the number of universities is limited and they are not based on quality of the program
