Changes in THE from 2014-2015 to 2015-2016 are the drop in Harvard's rank from two to six and the addition of one more European university (ETH). Nine of the top 2015-2016 for THE and QS are the same for the world and Asia. The order differs. To measure the real significance of this requires looking at the scores for both, as we can see in the Asian rankings. Asian universities fare better in QS; change in metrics seems to have had an impact in the scores for the two Korean technology universities, KAIST and Pohang.
