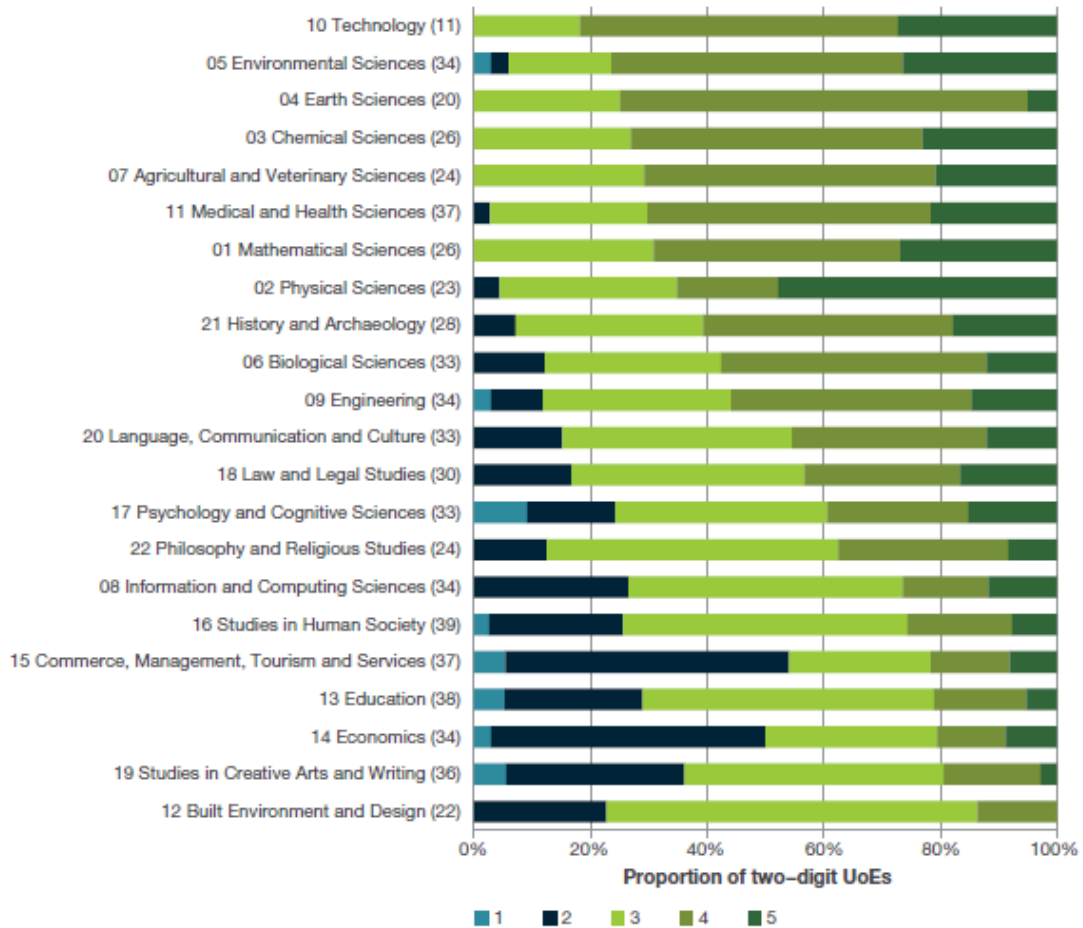

Australia uses a wide range of indicators plus human input to create its ratings.

Over 50% of ratings for ten codes are at four or five while eight categories have eight categories have ratings of 1 or 2.
