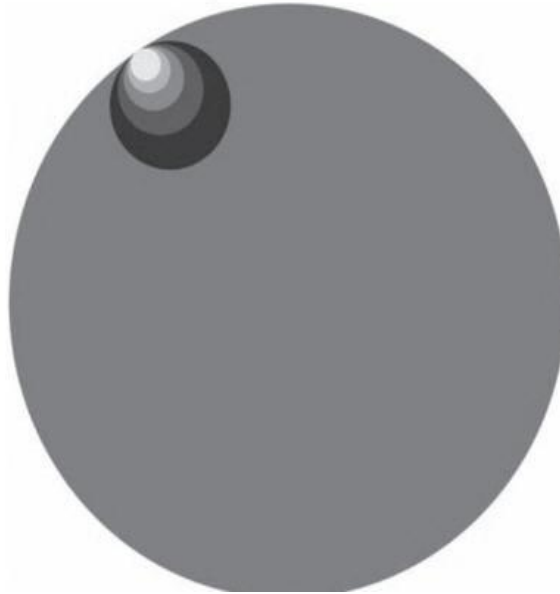


Figure 1.1 World university rankings: the top 50/100/200/400/800 as a proportion of all the world's universities.
